CLASS BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

The following is expected of all Choir Students everyday in class.
Students earn a possible 10 points total per day for class participation.

AT THE START OF CLASS it is expected that students will:

- Attend class and be in the choir room when the bell rings
- Get rid of all food, gum, and drink with the exception of water
- Place all materials not needed for class in the cubby
- Turn off electronic devices and keep them out of sight
- Have their music and a pencil and be in assigned seat when warm-ups begin

(2 points total per day)

DURING WARM-UPS it is expected that students will:

- Stand and sit properly for singing
- Focus and concentrate to improve your voice and the sound of the choir
- Pay attention and refrain from talking
- Get water, tissue, or use restroom before or after warm-ups

(2 points total per day)

DURING CLASS REHEARSAL it is expected that students will maintain the behaviors above and:

WHEN IT IS YOUR TURN TO SING:

- Stand and sit properly for singing
- Sing and stop singing when instructed to do so
- Listen to the director and follow instructions

WHEN IT IS SOMEONE ELSE'S TURN TO SING:

- Focus and study the music – your part and others'
- Contribute to a productive and efficient choir rehearsal by staying focused, being quiet, and respectfully encouraging others do the same

AND IN GENERAL:

- Pay attention and refrain from talking when the director is on the podium, at the piano, or otherwise addressing the choir
- Talk to others as equals and work for the good of the choir
- Get water, tissue, or go to restroom when it is someone else's turn to sing

(5 points total per day)

AT THE END OF CLASS it is expected that students will

- Stay in seat until the director dismisses the choir
- Put music away in proper slot

(1 point total per day)
